Code of conduct for Club coaches, team managers, officials and other volunteers

Southport Waterloo Athletics Club recognises the essence of good ethical conduct and practice as summarised below. All volunteers must:

- put the well-being and safety of athletes before the development of performance;
- develop an appropriate working relationship with athletes, based on mutual trust and respect;
- make sure all activities are appropriate to the age, ability and experience of those taking part;
- promote the positive aspects of the sport (e.g. fair play);
- display consistently high standards of behaviour and appearance;
- follow all guidelines laid down by the UK Athletics, the North of England Athletic Association and the Club:
- hold the appropriate, valid qualifications and insurance cover;
- never exert undue influence over athletes to obtain personal benefit or reward;

- never condone rule violations, rough play, inappropriate conduct or language or the use of prohibitive substances.
