The role of the Assistant Junior Athlete Coach

Assistant Junior Athlete Coaches will usually be level 1 coaches but could be higher graded if working under the supervision or direction of a level 3 or higher coach.

They will be work under the direction of the Junior Athlete Coach.

An Assistant Junior Athlete Coach will:

- Be responsible to the Junior Athlete Coach for the delivery of coaching sessions at a particular venue, as agreed and directed by the Junior Athlete Coach
- Whilst assisting the Junior Athlete Coach they may coach any athletic discipline
- Help the Junior Athlete Coach in the preparation of coaching sessions in advance
- Help the Junior Athlete Coach ensure all health and safety requirements are met
- Comply with the Club's code of conduct for coaches, team managers and other volunteers
- Ensure junior members comply with the obligations the club places on them
- Ensure the club's equity policy is complied with in training sessions
- Assist team managers in the selection of teams
- Let the Junior Athlete Coach they are working with know if they cannot attend any training or coaching sessions
